Graduate Policy Committee

Annual Report, 2020-2021

By the end of the 2020-2021 regular academic year, the GPC will have met 19 times, plus two emergency sessions conducted asynchronously during Summer, 2020.

The GPC revised the following university-wide policies:

- Preliminary exam policy (changes made to who authorizes a second attempt, and timing of the second attempt)
- Manuscript clearance defense grade definitions (added one grade for a total of four; created/clarified written definitions)
- University-wide Graduate Teaching Assistant Standards (added category 5, major revisions to category 2, minor revisions throughout)
- Retention GPA for professional programs (clarified general policy, governing body, definition of professional programs, and exceptions)
- Minimum enrollment for students after 6 thesis or 24 dissertation hours (changed from 3 to 2)

Seven programs/units were reviewed as part of their QER:

- In fall, Geography, Interdisciplinary Program in Humanities, Urban & Regional Planning.
- In spring 2021, International Affairs, Anthropology, Motion Picture, and iSchool.
