Re: Elections Committee Year-End Report for Academic Year 2021-2022
The Elections Committee consists of three senators appointed by the Faculty Senate Steering Committee; each appointee must come from a separate college. The Elections Committee conducts Senate and University elections involving faculty. In February, the Election Committee prepared the ballots for Specialized Faculty and circulated to the members of large units and the (at-large) individual units, allowing two weeks for nominations and two weeks for the return of the ballots. In March the Elections Committee prepared the ballots for the Grievance Committee and circulated them to all members of the General Faculty, allowing two weeks for the return of ballots. At the April Faculty Senate meeting, the Elections Committee prepared the ballots and conducted the election of the Senate President and the Steering Committee.

The Specialized Faculty elections were conducted in February 2022 on Qualtrics.

In October 2020, the faculty senate approved changes to the FSU constitution regarding the makeup of its members and to raise the number of specialized faculty to ten. In order to, stagger specialized faculty senator elections, each year 5 of the 10 seats are up for election. Furthermore, the Senate bylaws require that at least 5 Colleges must be represented and there are at least 1 teaching, 1 research and 1 libraries faculty in the 10 elected specialized faculty. In 2022, 5 senators were returning therefore 5 senators were elected, all of them for 2 year terms. 2 of the open seats were large-unit (for College of Medicine and University Libraries) and 3 were at-large-unit. The Faculty Senate Grievance Committee elections were conducted in March, 2022 on Qualtrics. In this committee each college or school shall have one representative; the Colleges of Education, Business, and Social Sciences shall have an additional representative; and the College of Arts and Sciences shall have four additional representatives. This year, nine (9) people needed to be elected this year for three-year terms (2022-2025) for the Committee - one (1) each from Arts \& Sciences, Education, Engineering, Health \&Human Sciences, Medicine, Nursing, and Social Work. As well as two (2) from Social Sciences \& Public Policy. As a result of the election the following faculty were elected as members of the committee for the 2022-2025 term:
