Graduate Policy Committee

Annual Report, 2023-2024

During the 2023-2024 regular academic year, the GPC met 16 times.

The GPC revised or implemented the following six university-wide policies:

- Replacement of the 60-Day deadline for manuscript clearance with a new timeline for redefense
- Updating of Defense Decision Definitions
- Clarification of required cumulative grade point average for graduate level certificates
- Policy on Dismissal for reasons other than GPA
- Change to the definition of full-time enrollment for graduate students (from 12 credits to 9 credits)
- Updates to the University-Wide TA Standards

Eight programs/units were reviewed as part of their QER:
